



# Two's "The Gospel Project" The Sermon on the Mount June 28, 2020

**Unit Key Passage:** *"The Holy Spirit ... will teach you all things." John 14:26 (CSB)*

**Bible Passage:** Matthew 5-7

**Main Point:** JESUS TAUGHT ABOUT GOD.

## Gospel Gems

- Jesus taught about God's kingdom.
- Jesus said believers are blessed even when bad things happen.
- Jesus' followers show other people what God is like.

## Supplies:

- Coloring Page
- Crayons
- "Lamp" printable
- yellow/orange tissue paper pieces
- stick glue

## 1 Getting Started

9:30-10:00

**All Team Members: Make sure you have a name tag on!**

A team member will stand at the door and be sure that the children are signed in while the other team members will engage the children as they enter the class. Be sure that you are asking to see the parent's security tags and making sure that the number is written on the sign in sheet and on the child's name tag. Greet new parents and introduce visitors.

## 2 Create the Story

10:00-10:30

### PLAY DOH TABLE

Provide play dough and play dough utensils. As the two's create items with play dough, invite them to think about obeying their parents. **SAY: JESUS TAUGHT ABOUT GOD.**

### 3 Snack & Teaching Time

10:30-10:50

#### **IMPORTANT!!!!**

**Please check each child for a yellow allergy sticker along with referring to the sign-in sheet to be properly informed on children who may have food and other allergies or their own snack.**

**NAME TAG SECURITY CHECKPOINT AT SNACK TIME** -Please check to ensure that each child is wearing a nametag which includes the family # written on it. Team members must check the family # on the nametag to the security tag that families present to you at sign-out time.

#### **SNACK/TEACHING TIME**

REMEMBER to pray prior to enjoying the snack. You can ask one of the children to pray or you might want to sing the “God our Father” song (to the tune of “Where is Thumbkin”). Lyrics as follows: “God our Father, God our Father, Once again, Once again, We bow our heads and thank you, We bow our heads and thank you, Amen, Amen”

**Snack:** Bananas and Cheerios

**Story Verses:** Matthew 5-7

**Story Prop:** Use the provided Bible Story Picture while sharing the Bible Story.

#### **BIBLE STORY FOR TWOS**

Jesus went up a mountain to teach about God’s kingdom. Jesus said, “Blessed are the poor in spirit, for God’s kingdom belongs to them. Blessed are those who are sad because they will be comforted. Blessed are the humble, for the earth will be theirs. Blessed are those who hunger and thirst for what God says is right, for they will be filled. Blessed are the merciful, for they will be shown mercy. Blessed are the pure in heart, for they will see God. Blessed are the peacemakers, for they will be called God’s children. Blessed are you when people punish you for doing what is right, for God’s kingdom belongs to you. You are the light of the world. Let your light shine so people will see you and praise God your Father.”

**Christ Connection:** People who trust in Jesus live like Him.

**DVD-** use the Gospel Project DVD to play the Bible story video **UNIT 23 SESSION 1 “The Sermon on the Mount”** You can play the DVD now, or when it fits best with the flow of the classroom.

**As a transition to Worship, sing the “Clean Up” song and help each child to throw away their trash at the table. Announce that it’s time to sing and gather all the children onto the red carpet and pass out instruments for them to use.**

## 4 Worship

10:50-11:00

Gather children to worship and hand out instruments for them to play as you sing several simple songs with them. You could also include a puppet during this time. Explain that we can sing to God about how much we love Him. **Open in prayer briefly reviewing the lesson and the gospel gems.**

### SING A SONG

Sing to the tune of “B-I-N-G-O”:

“ Jesus came to teach people all about God’s kingdom!  
Jesus taught about God [Clap each syllable, repeat 3x.]  
And how to live in His kingdom!”

**SAY: JESUS TAUGHT ABOUT GOD.** Jesus is a King, and people who trust in Jesus live like Him. Jesus’ followers show other people what God is like.

**Use the Gospel Project DVD provided to access the Music Videos. Unit 23 Preschool Theme song and Session 1 Key Passage Song. Encourage the children to participate by doing the hand motions along with the song.**

**Other Worship Songs (allow children to use instruments to play while singing)**

- This Little Light of Mine
- Jesus Loves Me
- Jesus Loves the Little Children
- My God is So Big
- If you’re happy and you know it
- I’ve got the Joy
- Rejoice in the Lord Always and Again I Say Rejoice

## 5 Game Time

11:00-11:15

### GOD’S CREATION GROSS MOTOR GAME

Instruct 2’s to follow your directions as they pretend to be animals by using their bodies. **SAY: JESUS OBEYED GOD’S PLAN.** God is good! GALLOP like a horse. STRETCH like a giraffe. HOP like a bunny. RUN like a cheetah. STOMP like an elephant. LAUGH like a hyena. FLAP like a bird. JUMP like a frog. SWING like a monkey. CHOMP like an alligator. WADDLE like a duck. SWIM like a fish. WALK slowly like a turtle. STAND like a flamingo. ROLL like a puppy. DANCE like you.

### Other Game Ideas –

Find Your Spot  
Ring Around the Rosie

### BUILD WITH BLOCKS

Provide blocks for babies to build a castle. You may show pictures of castles from an electronic device or picture book. Talk about the Bible story. **SAY: Jesus taught about God’s kingdom. God’s kingdom is very different than kingdoms of this world. Jesus said believers are blessed even when bad things happen. JESUS TAUGHT ABOUT GOD.**

**As soon as Game time is over, direct them to the table for craft time.**

## **6 Craft**

**11:15-11:30**

### **“The Sermon on the Mount” COLORING PAGE**

Write each child’s name on their coloring page. Provide crayons or markers and encourage two year olds to color their pictures.

### **MAKE LAMP ART**

Print a copy of the “Lamp” printable for each child. Show kids how to glue pieces of yellow and orange tissue paper onto their page Talk about the Bible story as you help the kids. **SAY: JESUS TAUGHT ABOUT GOD.** He said we are lights in a dark world. Jesus’ followers show other people what God is like.

## **7 Diaper Changes/Potty Breaks & Clean Up**

**11:30-11:40**

**Ask the children to help you put the toys away.**

Let one team member begin diaper changes/potty breaks, as the children are finishing up their craft/playtime. Another team member can be cleaning up and picking up the toys. Plan to put the toys away either in their boxes or up onto the counter. This is a time for the children to begin to “wind down” as we wait for their parents to come and pick them up.

### **Clean Up Song:**

**“Clean up, clean up, everybody everywhere. Clean up, clean up, everybody do their share.”**  
**You can also sing to the tune of “The Wheels on the Bus Go ‘Round and ‘Round” and insert whatever activity you are doing For Example, “Let’s put all the toys away, toys away, toys away. Let’s put all the toys away. Let’s put them all away.”**

## **8 Reading Circle / Calm Time**

**11:40-12:00**

### **Reading Circle-Calm Time**

Insert one of the “quiet music” CD’s into the CD player to play in the background. Gather the children together on the floor. There will be books available to read, and puzzles to play with. One team member will select a story to read to them. The other team members should sit amongst the children on the carpet. Keep the children engaged by asking them questions about the story that you’re reading. If they wish, the children may have their own book to look at while a team member is reading to them.
